

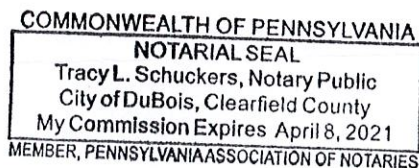

The Township of Sandy intends to submit a grant application for \$156,959 to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for CDBG funding assistance. The application due date is undetermined at this time, but will most likely be due in November, 2019. The Township is proposing to utilize the 2019 FFY CDBG funds for the following activities:

Platt Road Sanitary Sewer Extension: \$128,707 (approx. 82%)

Program Administration: \$28,252 (approx. 18%)

Total FFY 2019 CDBG Assistance: \$156,959

The proposed project is a multi-year funded project. With the project, no displacement of families or individuals will be involved. The Township has established a goal of 5% (approx. \$6,435.35) for minimum participation by Minority Business Enterprises and 3% (approx. \$3,861.21) for Women Business Enterprises.

The sanitary sewer extension project was tentatively selected after a public meeting was held on July 15, 2019 at the Sandy Township Municipal Building. The meeting was held to obtain citizens' views and comments on the Township's prior use of CDBG funds, how CDBG funds should be used in the future and to help identify any needs with respect to low and moderate-income (LMI) families and individuals. Citizen input into the Three-Year Community Development Plan was also invited at the meeting.

A second public meeting will be held on September 16, 2019 at 6:30 P.M. at the Sandy Township Municipal Building, 1094 Chestnut Avenue, DuBois, PA 15801. The purpose of the meeting is to elaborate on the proposed use of CDBG funds and to allow for citizens' comments and questions.

Assuming that the Township's FFY 2019 CDBG application will be due in November, the application is to be considered for final approval by the Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting beginning at 7:00 P.M., on October 21, 2019.

Written comments on the proposed use of FFY 2019 CDBG funds will tentatively be accepted until 3:30 P.M. on October 15, 2019 and may be forwarded to the Sandy Township Supervisors, P.O. Box 267, 1094 Chestnut Ave., DuBois, PA 15801. A copy of the draft application will tentatively be available for inspection during regular business hours (7:30 A.M. - 3:30 P.M), except holidays, from October 7, 2019 through October 11, 2019.

The location of the hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities.
