

Municipal Disaster Emergency Declaration
Sandy Township
Clearfield County, Pennsylvania

Whereas, the municipality of Sandy Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania has been impacted by, or is immediately threatened by, a (natural/technological/national or state security) event.

Now, therefore, we, the Sandy Township Board of Supervisors, declare that a local disaster emergency exists in the Municipality and that we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Pennsylvania Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the Municipality for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the people of this Municipality and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances, and resolutions and particularly to Pennsylvania Code Title 35; Chapter 73; Section 7301 (c).

All public offices and employees of Sandy Township are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives—state and local.


All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.


All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations directly to the designated Municipal Emergency Operating Center.
